

52-year female with type 2 diabetes for 9 years is admitted to the vascular surgery service for evaluation of cellulitis in the left foot. She has blockage in the left femoral-popliteal system. Information about her diabetes management:

- BMI 36, A1C 8.9, Creatinine 1.2
- · Glargine insulin and insulin aspart aspart as an outpatient
- Hypoglycemia 1X/week usually in the afternoon.
- At one-month post-discharge, would you advise modification to her therapy or management?
- · If so, what and why?
