





NCD Alliance:

Survey on experiences and expectations towards an inclusive NCD agenda regarding conditions outside the '5x5' approach with a focus on Endocrine conditions

Noncommunicable diseases (NCDs) are the biggest contributor to death and disability worldwide, accounting for up to 41 million deaths annually.

The NCD Alliance is running a survey as part of the consultation on the needs and priorities of people living with NCDs outside the-"5x5" approach, with a specific focus on endocrine conditions. The survey aims to compile the interests, experiences and expectations of the community, in order to develop a

policy brief putting forward recommendations to policymakers and health programming organizations to facilitate a more inclusive NCD agenda.
